The stages of development can be divided into the primary dentition, early mixed dentition, late mixed dentition, adolescent dentition and adult dentition. Among these, the early mixed dentition stage is one of the stages where early diagnosis of malocclusion can be made.</p> <p>This forum will focus on the early mixed dentition, starting from the essential factors which influence a smooth transition from the primary to the permanent dentition and identifying what is normal during this stage of development.
