Presentation Title:	LUNCH & LEARN: STABILIZING TRAUMATISED TEETH
ABSTRACT	<p>Trauma to teeth occur due to falls, altercations, vehicular accidents, and sports accidents. The most commonly involved teeth are the maxillary incisors. When accompanied by a jaw fracture, the fracture is usually managed with splints and/or arch bars together with rigid fixation with or without maxillomandibular fixation. However, when only the teeth are involved then a simple splint using composite filling material and orthodontic wire or fiber reinforced cord can be used. In this lunch and learn session the indications and procedure for splinting these traumatized teeth will be discussed.</p>
