ABSTRACT	<p>The General Practitioner is usually the first to encounter crowding in the early mixed dentition stage and a consultation with an orthodontist is then usually recommended. But if the patient fails to get treatment at the proper time, the opportunity to intercept the malocclusion is lost. A quick review of the serial extraction protocol for the general practitioner can greatly aid in the resolution of crowding and achieve guided eruption. With proper diagnosis, sequencing and timing, serial extraction will be the simplest way to produce the desired result.</p>
