<p>ABSTRACT</p>	<p>Treatment of periodontal disease diagnostic of trauma from occlusion is an essential part of complete periodontal therapy and restoration of health in the masticatory system. A dentist who completely ignores occlusal therapy for periodontal trauma will fail to attain complete periodontal health. Occlusal therapy by itself, will not treat gingivitis or periodontitis caused by bacteria and its by-products. However, it may facilitate plaque control and treatment of patients with periodontal disease. The importance for the control of occlusal factors is to establish a stable occlusion with the least interference to plaque control and periodontal maintenance. This lecture presentation will deal with specific aspects of combined malocclusion and periodontal disease, in which orthodontic treatment and or TMJ treatment may improve or be essential to optimal results of periodontal therapy and maintenance.</p>
