Presentation Title: MANAGING COMMON ENDODONTIC PROBLEMS

ABSTRACT

Root canal treatment aims to remove inflamed or infected pulp tissue from the root canal system to maintain or restore the function of an involved tooth. In the process, some stumbling blocks may be encountered in gaining access to the root canal system, efficiently cleaning and shaping the root canals and obturating the tooth. This presentation will cover the management of treatment challenges such as the identification of the involved tooth, management of the patient who is in pain, management of perforations, adequate disinfection of the root canal system and the accomplishment of a three-dimensional obturation of all the canals.
