Presentation Title: PRIVACY, SECURITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF PATIENTS' HEALTH INFORMATION

As a healthcare professional, ensuring the "privacy, security, and confidentiality" of patients' health information is one of the primary responsibilities of any dentist. Although these three essential and related concepts are often used interchangeably when referring to the protection of health information, it is critical that every healthcare provider fully understands that each has a different fundamental meaning and distinct role. This lecture aims to discuss the relevance and application of these concepts in the dental office setting; and present some important issues about the implications and challenges of safeguarding our patients' rights to privacy in the digital age.
